Horse Requirements

For the FEIF Trainer 1 Exam each participant shall bring a minimum of two horses and maximum of three horses. Each horse must be used in at least one work in hand exam and at least one ridden exam. One of the horses used must have been in training with the examinee for a minimum of 6 weeks.

For the USIHC Basic Instructor Exam each participant shall bring a minimum of one horse and maximum of two horses. There are no training requirements per duration of training with the examinee prior to the exam.

In order to ensure horse welfare examiners may decide to check the horses equipment, shoeing, and general health at any time. Examiners may disqualify a horse from use in the exam based on any findings during a health check.

All FEIF Sport Competition rules for equipment and shoeing apply during the exams except when otherwise stated in the exam description.
