President Report - No News VP Report - No News Treasurer - Sabrina doing great. Membership - 854 members, 662 Households

Updated WC tryout document - new scores for youth riders, changes in reserve horse, and some phrasing. Leslie motions, Jeff 2nd, unanimous.

Old Business - Trainer Certification - test re-takes scheduled for June. One candidate was asking for free re-tests. We're proposing first re-test free, subsequent tests are \$100 each.

New Business - Trying to focus on promoting inclusivity in sport shows - education, fun-days, fun classes, ensuring that our oval track events are fun for all the membership. Board discussed various ways to promote support, feedback, and encouragement. Perhaps at the end of the day judges could be available? Access to judges, access to scoresheets, having a way to maximize

the feedback to help riders and support people through all the classes. Scribes are important - trying to match right scribes with right judges. Discussion turns to utilization of finals, which will not be resolved this evening, but will remain an ongoing topic intwined with the challenge of offering more shows for less money.

Voting 4

Amendment 3

Lower the score for adults in Five gait to 5.8. The survey showed 2/3 in favor.

After discussion back and forth, Virginia made a motion to stick to 6.0 for all tests. Leslie seconded. Voting 8 approved, 4 disapproved and 2 abstained. Motion was approved.

Amendment 4

Lowering scores for Young rider in Five gait to 5.5. Majority agrees in the survey.

Amendment 5

Allowing more slots for Young riders in all disciplines. 5 in each since we are allowed to send 5 young riders to the World Championships, and it might not be evenly spread between the disciplines. Majority agreed on the survey.

Asta asked Jeff if he would be willing to form a sub committee to developed the "flex" spot idea further and make it in to an amendment to be added to the document. Jeff, Carrie, Jana and Virginal have agreed to work on this proposal.

Virginia proposed. Concurrent with the establishment of the (National) team, the USIHC will dedicate funds and appoint a sub-committee to create a "Development" or "Training" team. This team will be open to all USIHC members, and for a nominal fee, will provide educational tools to those interested in sport riding.

Approved to be added to the Board meeting next week to then have a sub committee formed to develop further.
